Your Unit's MRC Program Website Profile

Every registered MRC unit has an online profile, and it is important to keep this profile up to date so that potential partners and volunteers can learn more about your unit. To see your unit's profile, visit the MRC Website listed above and click on the "Join a Local MRC Unit" button. You will be taken to a GIS website where you navigate to your unit.

The Listservs

One-Way Listserv

The Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) Program offers two types of listserv options. First is a one-way listserv which is used by the MRC Program to share information on upcoming events, new resources, changes to the Website, and major announcements. Click here to subscribe or unsubscribe to the one-way listserv.

Two-Way Listserv

The MRC Program also offers a two-way listserv to allow for those active in the program to share ideas, resources, best practices, and lessons learned. This listserv is conversational and allows for great interaction between units, the MRC Program, and others involved in the program. Messages from the MRC Program will also be cross-posted on the two-way listserv.
